#### WHAT TO KNOW

Everyone 6 months and older should get a 2024-2025 COVID-19 vaccine dose. Protection from the vaccine decreases with time, especially as the virus mutates into different variants. Flu season is approaching; it is safe to get the COVID-19 vaccine and flu shot at the same time.

#### **DIFFERENCE BETWEEN BRANDS**

Moderna and Pfizer: available for

people ages 6 months+

Novavax: available for people ages 12+

## GETTING THE UPDATED COVID-19 VACCINE IS ESPECIALLY IMPORTANT IF YOU:

- Never received a COVID-19 vaccine
- Are ages 65 years and older
- Are at <u>high risk for severe COVID-19</u>
- Are living in a long-term care facility
- Are <u>pregnant</u>, <u>breastfeeding</u>, <u>trying to get</u>
  <u>pregnant</u>, <u>or might become pregnant in the</u>
  future
- Want to lower your risk of getting Long COVID
